Profile Notes: According to ipezzimancanti.it; April 21, 2006: On April 21, 2006 Italian Judges sentenced to life imprisonment, Giuseppe Calò and six other associates, for the murder of an Italian Magistrate. According to archivioantimafia.org; December 13, 2002: On December 13, 2002 the Court of Assizes of Appeal of Palermo confirmed the sentence given it the first instance against Giuseppe Calò and his associates. According to archivioantimafia.org; June 24, 2002: On June 24, 2002 the Court of Assizes of Appeal of Caltanissetta sentenced Giuseppe Calò to life imprisonment for money laundering, organized crime and murder. The mobster, previously arrested on June 12, 1997, was behind several murders and massacres, including the bombing of the Express train 904 on December 23, 1984, where 15 people died and over 200 were injured. In the 1970's, according to the Judges, Calò laundered large amounts of money for several 'Cosa Nostra' families.
