1 Introduction

1.1 Overview

Dynamics 365 Creditsafe Connect is an add-on to Dynamics 365 CE. The add-on support integration to Creditsafe and the possibility to search, create and monitor Account and Lead in the Creditsafe database inside Dynamics 365 CE GUI. Dynamics 365 Creditsafe Connect is developed and supported by Endeavor.

Key Features:

- Search for companies
- Create accounts and leads
- Possibility to manually update accounts
- Possibility to manually update leads
- Monitoring of accounts scheduling of automatic updates
- Enable monitoring inside CE (per account)
- Custom mapping of fields
- Open detailed report in web GUI (Only valid for Sweden Search)

It is however possible to run Dynamics 365 Creditsafe Connect on older versions of Dynamics CRM and on an On-Premise version, but that requires manual upgrades using older versions of the solution.

2 Functionality

2.1 Search for companies via Account – Create new Account

Use "Search Creditsafe" in Account view to search for new accounts.




Fig: 1. Search Creditsafe in Account

Search window: Type Company name or Registration Number and select Country



Fig:2. Search in the Creditsafe database




Fig:3. Result list after search in the Creditsafe database.

Select the company in the list and create an Account or a Lead.






Fig 4: A new account has been created.



2.1.1 Search for companies' Ultimate parent

If a company is part of a group, it is possible to show their ultimate parent company. Press the button and it will be replaced by the Company name.




Fig 5: Ultimate Parent in Result View

Info about Ultimate parent is only visible if System Parameter "Show Ultimate Parent" = Yes.

For Company Search Sweden the Ultimate parent button is only visible when the company is part of a group.

For GGS the Ultimate parent button will be visible for all companies in the search list even if the company is not part of a group.

2.2 Search for companies via Account – that already exists in your CRM




Fig:6. Search in the Creditsafe database






Fig:7. Result list after search in the Creditsafe database.

Search Result:

- If a company exists in your CRM system, it has a green highlight color.
- Icons show if the company exists as a Lead: or as an Account



2.3 Link an existing account to Creditsafe

It is possible to link an existing account in Dynamics 365 CE to an account in the Creditsafe database. Click on Creditsafe Update and you are prompted with a question to map the account to Creditsafe.




Fig:8. Existing account record without mapping to Creditsafe.





Fig:9. Verify that you map against correct company, and click Update Account








Fig:10. Account record mapped to Creditsafe.



2.4 Manual update via Account

2.4.1 Single update of Account

Manual update of information by pressing "Creditsafe Update" on an account. The account will be updated with the latest available information to the fields you have mapped with Creditsafe. Read more about mapping below.




Fig:11. Update a single Account.

2.4.2 Multi update of Account

Update accounts by selecting one or more companies in your view and press "Update Account(s)"




Fig:12. Update multiple Accounts.







Fig:13. Update info after updating multiple Accounts.



2.5 Creditsafe web, HTML-report (Only for Sweden)

Access Creditsafe detailed report (HTML) through Creditsafe Web button in Account in CRM.



Report is in web format letting user click on all tabs and get detailed information about rating, history, board members etc.

In Creditsafe Web you configure a Credit template defining Credit Rating for your accounts. Type in the name of the template in Creditsafe Configuration for Company Search Sweden – field "Credit Worthiness Template" and the template will be used when updating your accounts Credit Rating in Dynamics.



2.6 Update Credit Rating – Accounts (Only for Sweden)

Update Credit Rating manually using "Update Credit Rating". This function uses the template defined in the field "Credit Worthiness Template" in Creditsafe Configuration for Company Search Sweden.





Fig:15. Update Credit Rating.



- Credit Rating: "Approved" in this example is defined in the Credit Worthiness Template
- Last Credit Report: Last time the Credit rating request was initiated.

Credit Limit, Rating and Rating Text is part of standard mapping.



2.7 Monitoring

Creditsafe Connect has an advanced function for monitoring data on your accounts on a regular basis.

When the monitoring job is run, the account will be checked for changes and if changed, the account record will be updated automatically.

2.7.1 Enable Monitoring per Creditsafe Configuration




Fig. 16. Enable Credit Monitoring on Creditsafe Configurations

Via Creditsafe Configuration you can enable monitoring by setting Use Monitoring to Yes. This gives you the flexibility to only run monitoring for Accounts linked via Sweden Company Search but not for Accounts linked to GGS, or vice versa.

When monitoring is enabled – see Enable Monitoring, Monitoring Last Run Date is updated.

2.7.2 Monitoring Account




Fig. 17. Credit Monitoring on Account.



If parameter "Use Monitoring" = Yes and an account is created directly via Search Creditsafe then Credit Monitoring [account.edp_cscreditmonitored] is set to Yes by default.

You can deactivate monitoring for a single account by setting Credit Monitoring to No, then no automatic updates will be made for that account.

Please note that Credit Monitoring [account.edp_cscreditmonitored] is set to No by default when creating new accounts manually in Dynamics 365 CE. Even if you link the account to Creditsafe, Credit Monitoring is still set to No.

If you manually change the value on Credit Monitoring to Yes, the company is added to the Creditsafe list of monitored companies. This can be done either on one account at a time or via multi update, the plugin that updates the monitoring list is run in both cases.

2.7.3 Enable Monitoring

Activate monitoring by setting Monitoring Enabled to Yes in the System Parameter form. This will initiate the monitoring job.

"Monitoring Next Execution" will be updated showing the time and date for the next execution of the monitoring process.




Fig:18. Enable monitoring



2.7.4 Monitoring – Test run

After you have configured the monitoring, you can initiate a single execution of a monitoring run. You execute this in System Parameter via "Run monitoring".

The purpose of this run is to secure that the current mapping works.




Fig:19. Test run monitoring





Fig:20. Result - Test run monitoring – succeeded!



3 Configuration

Use the Creditsafe Admin app to access System Parameter and Creditsafe Configurations.



3.1 System Parameters

System Parameters consists of no data on installation.

Add a System Parameter record, set a name and set Enabled to Yes. See suggested values below:






Fig:21. System Parameters

3.2 Creditsafe Configurations

In Creditsafe Configurations you define which search engine you use.

"CompanySearch-Sweden" for Sweden Companies and "Creditsafe-GGS" for Companies outside Sweden is the two existing search engines.

Each configuration record has its own set of parameters.

You define mapping per configuration. Possible per entity (account and lead) to map fields available in Creditsafe API. It is possible to map fields to standard Dynamics CRM fields as well as for custom added fields.




Fig:22. Creditsafe Configurations




Fig:23. Creditsafe Configuration CompanySearch Sweden




Fig:24. Creditsafe Configuration Creditsafe GGS




Fig:26. Creditsafe Attribute CompanySearch Sweden




Fig:28. Default mapping Lead for CompanySearch Sweden




Fig:30. List of mapped fields for Account Creditsafe GGS






Fig:31. Creditsafe Attribute Creditsafe GGS




Fig:32. Default mapping Account for Creditsafe GGS




Fig:33. Default mapping Lead for Creditsafe GGS



3.2.5 Entity Mapping Is List – for Creditsafe-GGS and Company Search Sweden

Mapping using the Is List function is described more in detail in this section. Below we use the Creditsafe GGS Configuration to describe the setup, but it works the same way using Company Search Sweden

- 1. Navigate to the "GGS" Creditsafe configuration entity ("edp_creditsafeconfiguration").
- 2. Navigate to a Creditsafe Configuration Entity, we will use Account in this demonstration.
- 3. You should now be presented with the following form.




Fig:35. List of mapped fields for Account Creditsafe GGS

4. Add a new Creditsafe attribute record via "New Creditsafe Attribute"






Fig:36. Creditsafe Attribute Creditsafe GGS

- 5. The "Creditsafe Field" field specifies which field in a Creditsafe company report to link to a "CRM Field", just as with non-list attributes. New is that one can now also specify list attributes, such as "Directors/CurrentDirectors/Director*/Name", taken from Creditsafe api documentation. The '*' specifies that there could be more than one element for each company. For example, there could be two directors in a company, say "Bob Burger" and "Alice Allstar".
- 6. If such a "list" field is entered, the "Is List" checkbox also needs to be checked, indicating that we do have a list attribute.






Fig:37. Creditsafe Attribute Creditsafe GGS

- 7. As can be seen in the screenshot above when the "Is List" checkbox is checked another field is shown. This "Related Entity Logical Name" field is the logical name of the entity where the data from each list element will be placed. These entities are linked to the account created for the company. More info about this entity under "Related Entity".
- 8. The Dynamics 365 Field now doesn't specify a field on an Account entity directly but instead on a field in the given "Related Entity", if the checkbox "Is List" is unchecked and a non-list Creditsafe attribute is given, the normal behavior is used again.






Fig:38. Creditsafe Attribute Creditsafe GGS

9. Say we have for a company the directors mentioned above. (Name: "Bob Burger", Gender: "Male") and (Name: "Alice Allstar", Gender: "Female"). Given the related entity and Dynamics 365 Field we have specified above, when creating/updating a company two "new_testlistentity" records will be created, with the field "new_name" in "new_testlistentity", filled with the Name of the directors, since we specified "Name" in the Creditsafe attribute field. A better name for "new_testlistentity" could in this case be "abc_Director". What if in the same entity we also want the gender information? Well this is doable, just add another Creditsafe attribute record, using the same Related entity, with a different Dynamics 365 Field that also exists in the Related Entity, and also tweak the Creditsafe Field to "Directors/CurrentDirectors/Director*/Gender".

3.2.6 Related entity:

The Related entity is the entity that is created per element in the returned list from Creditsafe. The specified Dynamics 365 Field needs to exist in this entity, there is a plugin check for this to help prevent mistakes. The Related entity also needs to have a field with lookup to the Entity, in this case Account. The fields name does not matter but could be on for example "abc_ParentAccountId". In plugin code the metadata is searched for this field that has an account lookup, (or lead). Because in every search/update there could be any number of Related Entities for different attribute, all Related Entities are deleted and then recreated again. Thus, adding or changing data in these entities manually should be avoided, as this will be lost if the account is updated.



4 Error handling Q/A

4.1 Create/Update Lead & Accounts.

- 4.1.1 Error message when creating/updating records in CRM using Creditsafe buttons: "A failure occurred in Web Api in Dynamics 365".
 - ➤ Navigate to Advanced Settings -> Settings -> Solutions -> Dynamics 365 Creditsafe Connect -> Processes.
 - Verify that all processes have status "Activated".




Fig:39. List of Processes in Creditsafe Connect

- ➤ If any process has status "Draft" you need to activate it.
- ➤ Make a note of the name of the process and navigate to Advanced Settings -> Settings -> Customizations -> Customize the system -> Processes.
- ➤ Locate the process you made a note of, select it, and click the "Activate" button.




Fig:40. Activate the process



4.2 Monitoring

4.2.1 My Accounts does not get updated by the monitoring function.

- Check that the monitoring job is running:
- ➤ Use Creditsafe Admin app -> Go to System Parameters
- > Check that Monitoring Enabled = Yes and you have a date and time in the Monitoring Next Execution:

If you do not have a date and time in the Monitoring Next Execution you need to check if the Monitoring Interval/Monitoring Interval Unit/Monitoring Start Time are correctly set. In either case you can change the Monitoring Enabled to No, update these attributes to have the expected values if needed, save the record. Then you may change the value back to Yes, and then save the record again. That should result in that the Monitoring Next Execution is given a value.

4.2.2 One of my Accounts is not updated via the monitoring function.

> Check that the Credit Monitoring is set to Yes on the account.

➤ If it still is not updated check the search engine (Creditsafe GGS or Sweden Company Search) and go to Creditsafe Configuration and check the current search engine that Use Monitoring = Yes.




Fig:43. Creditsafe Configuration Creditsafe GGS / Sweden Company Search

4.3 Access

4.3.1 Do we have any pre-configured user groups within Creditsafe Connect?

- > Creditsafe Connect contains two security roles:
 - o Creditsafe Basic User For the normal CE user.



o Creditsafe Admin User – For admin to configure and monitor Creditsafe setup.




Fig:44. Security Roles

4.4 Mapping to Creditsafe Internal ID via Excel

- 4.4.1 Is it possible to map accounts to Creditsafe by updating CS internal ID via an Excel import, or do you need to map each account separately?
 - It is possible to import accounts using Excel and map them to Creditsafe.
 - After importing you need to click on "Update Accounts(s)" in list mode after selecting one or more accounts. You can also click on Creditsafe Update in the account form (for a single account).
 - Worth knowing is that it is not enough with just CS Internal ID, there are some other fields that need to be specified also for the account to be considered connected.

Fields needed in the Excel file (or needs to be filled in):

- Organization Number [account.edp_orgno], e.g.: 06610464
- CS Internal Id [account.edp_CreditSafeId], e.g.: GB003/0/06610464 (this may only be retrieved from any of the available Creditsafe interfaces or by contacting Creditsafe for an export of some sort)
- Visit Country [account.edp_Address1_CountryId], e.g.: Great Britain (lookup to entity edp_country)
- ➤ Search Engine [account.edp_creditsafesearchengine], e.g.: Global Company Search (value: 757550001)
- Creditsafe Connected [account.edp_connectedtocreditsafe] must be set to "Yes"
- Credit Monitoring [account.edp_cscreditmonitored] must be set to No at this point (setting it to yes will not automatically add the company to the monitoring list in Creditsafe, so setting it to Yes will be confusing)

If you get this data and click on "Creditsafe Update" on an account created as above you will not get the question "this account is not mapped to Creditsafe, do you want to map it now?" - the record will be immediately updated with the new CS info.



If the account is considered Creditsafe connected, an update of the field Credit Monitoring from No to Yes will mean that a plugin is executed which via Creditsafe's web service adds the company to the "watch list". This can be done either on one account at a time or via multi update, the plugin that updates the CS list is run in both cases.

4.5 Product license

4.5.1 For how long is the product license valid?

- Navigate to Advanced Settings -> Settings -> Solutions -> Dynamics 365 Creditsafe Connect -> Configuration.
- In License Xml you have the time limit for the license.




Fig:45. Product License for Dynamics 365 Creditsafe Connect

- Product license for production environments is valid for a year at a time.
- > Product license for evaluation purposes is normally valid only one month.
